   1st or 2nd tier suppliers












# Key SCORE Training Impacts at the Enterprise Level





# Case Study: CV Kreatif Bali Trading (2016)



- Garment company (export)
- SCORE implementation result:
  - Better result for social compliance audit
  - Efficiency increased from 46% to 87%
  - Energy consumption is down by 27% due to the simple renovation resulting energy efficiency in the working area (pics below)

# Case Study: CV Kreatif Bali Trading (2016)



- SCORE implementation result:
  - Reject rate decreased by 5%
  - Benefit from 5S activities: USD 60,150 gained from reselling the reject products that were abandoned before


# Case Study: Lestari Dini Tunggul (2012)



- Garment Company in Indonesia (export market)
- Improvement made: Re-layout work floor, 5S for storage and production floor
- Result: Productivity increase 80%, Sales target increase 60%
